

RIVERSHORE INFORMATION and LOCAL RULES

General Information:

1. **PACE OF PLAY:** A foursome should expect to complete 18 holes at Rivershore in 4 hours and 15 minutes or less. The first two hours of tee times each day requires a pace of play of 4 hours or less.
2. **GREEN STAKES WITH YELLOW TOPS** indicate where power carts are forbidden. Please keep power carts out of these staked areas.
3. **CARE OF THE COURSE:** Players are expected to replace or repair all divots, including on teeing grounds, repair all the ball marks on the greens and smooth bunkers by raking footprints and other irregularities. Please place rakes inside the bunkers.

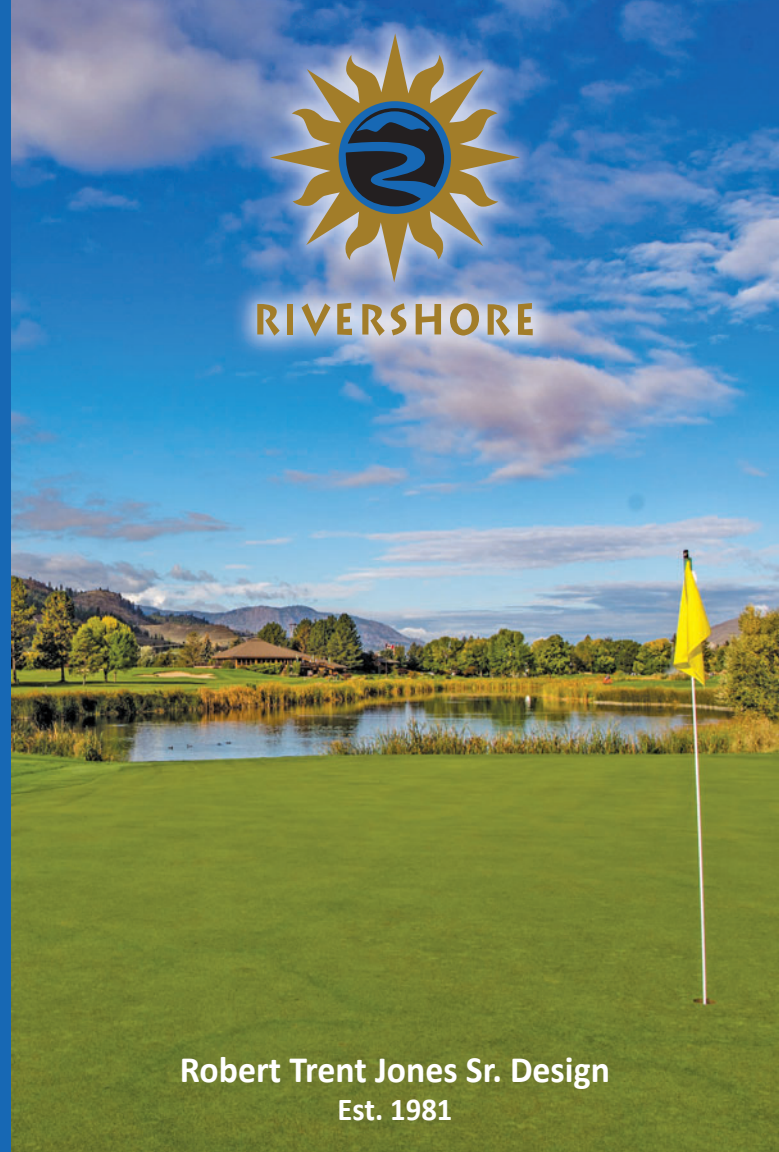
PLAY IS GOVERNED BY THE 2019 RULES OF GOLF PUBLISHED BY GOLF CANADA AND, WHERE APPLICABLE, BY THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES:

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS** is defined by white stakes, the boundary fence post on the left side of hole 8, and the road to the left of holes 1 and 2. A ball lying on or beyond the road is out of bounds. Rule 18 applies. The Wastewater Treatment System to the right of holes 13, 14 and 15 is out of bounds defined by the fence posts.
2. **ALTERNATIVE TO STROKE AND DISTANCE FOR LOST BALL OR BALL OUT OF BOUNDS** (Model Local Rule E-5) is in effect. For two penalty strokes relief may be taken by dropping a ball in his or her relief area.
3. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR)** includes all flower beds, and rock gardens on the course and any areas marked by white lines. Rule 16 applies.
4. **PENALTY AREAS** are defined by yellow stakes or lines and/or red stakes or lines. Rule 17 applies. For play of holes 8 and 16, lateral relief on the opposite of the red penalty area is an additional option, using a reference point for relief that is the same distance from the hole as where the original ball last crossed the edge of the red penalty area.
5. **HYDRO LINES:** If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line, or insulator the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made. (See Rule 14.6)


